This support includes mooring/un-mooring, monitoring fire and flooding alarms/indicators, dehumidification, survey/inspection for hazardous materials, (e.g. PCBs, asbestos, radiological materials, hazardous materials and fuel removal,) exterior preservation, support for equipment removal/cannibalization, preparations for tow, and preparations for SINKEX. Sharp is also responsible for receipt, inspection, survey, maintenance and disposal of Naval vessels in locations other than the NISMF (which includes sites outside of the state of Washington).
